Was living in Las Vegas, New Mexico, in 1943. Addressed "Resp. Cousin" Mr. Luther E. Shuck to be sure the Brown Bible be delivered only to a male member ("son - grandson or great grandson only -- not to any of the Femanine Gender"), of the Late F.H.T. Brown; signed "your Kindsman" Wm E. Brown, Feb. 7th, 1944
- ii. Frances P. Brown was born in Butler Co. Kansas October 3rd 1878 6 O.C.A.M.
Died 15 days afterward
- iii. Barbara Beatrice Brown was born March 29th 1886 in Butler Co. Kansas 11 O.C.A.M.
