David Hopkins wife Know all Men by these presents that we David Hopkins and Rhoda Hopkins his Wife of the City of Fleming & State of Kentucky for the purpose of conveying to John Brown of the County of Washington Pennsylvania all our right title & Interest claim & demand in a tract of land lying & being in the County of Washington Pennsylvania Nottingham Township formerly the property of John Brown Deceased & do further empower said John Brown to collect all rents arrearsages &c. that may be due for said place & make use of the same to his benefit & behoof to him & his heirs or assigns & do relinquish for ourselves heirs &c. forever to him & his heirs & assigns forever whereunto we have affixed our hands & seals this 1<sup>st</sup> day of Jay 1816.
