This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of March in the
year of our lord one thousand seven hundred ninety four
by and between William Brown and Patience his wife of this
County in the state of Virginia of the one part and Joseph Brown John
Brown and Anne Brown heirs of John Brown late of Nottingham County
in Washington County and state of Pennsylvania Dec. of the other part
Witnesseth that the said William Brown and Patience his wife for and
in consideration of the just and full sum of ten shillings of good and
lawfull money of the state of Pennsylvania appaid to them in hand paid
by the said Joseph, John and Anne Brown before the making and
delivery of these presents the receipt where of the said William Brown
doth hereby acknowledge and himself therewith fully satisfied contented
and paid hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents
doth for themselves their heirs Executors and Administrators grant bargain
and sell unto the said Joseph, John and Anne Brown their heirs or
Assigns forever the following piece or part of a tract of land in Nottingham
Township aforesaid called twenty seven and bounded as followeth begin-
ing at a highway (John Munn's land) then North forty eight west sixty
two perches to a white Oak then (2) north fifteen degrees west nine perches to
a white Oak then (3) north thirty three west seventeen ft. and a half to a
highway (4) north fifty five deg. west thirty nine and a half perch to a highway
then (5) north fourteen East ninety nine ft. to a stump (6) north thirty
four east seventy two ft. to a post and to oak (7) south eighty one deg.
east twenty nine ft. to oak (8) south forty five east fourteen ft. to oak
(9) south seven seven degrees east sixteen perches to a post (10) south twenty
